



Drugs & Alcohol

Alburgh with Denton & Harleston Preschool Nurseries takes its Safeguarding of children very seriously. All staff employed at the setting are safe and fit to do so.

Staff are expected when they arrive for the start of a session to be in a suitable condition to work.

The Preschool will not accept a member of staff or a student to come to work under the influence of drugs or alcohol. They will be challenged and asked to leave immediately.

On their return to work the member of staff will receive a warning about their conduct, any repeat of this behavior will result in disciplinary action taken.

The health and safety of our children is very important to us, therefore any parent or carer who arrives at the setting to collect their child and is clearly unfit to do so will be challenged. The following procedure will take place;

Efforts will be made by staff to contact another member of the child's family, to
ensure that the child/ren are escorted home in safety by someone who is
authorised to do so. Failing to make contact with another person, OFSTED
will be notified, and children's Services will begin the process for the child/ren
being look after until an appropriate adult can be sought.

Staff will consult with the **Children's Advice & Duty Service (CADS) team** and seek their guidance as to actions which may need to be taken, to ensure the safety of the child/ren within the family.
