



Soiled Clothes

It may be necessary whilst your child is at the nursery to change your child into clean clothes. Disposable protective gloves will be worn by staff at all times whilst attending to a child's needs. Any clothing soiled or clothing heavily dirtied whilst participating in any activities or due to a toileting accident will be removed and replaced with clean clothes.

All dirty clothes will be deposited in a sealed bag and returned to the parent/ carer concerned. Unless the clothing (such as underwear) is so badly soiled that staff may decide it is preferable to dispose of it.

It is helpful to staff and your child, if you bring to each session at least one complete change of clothing for your child, in case of such emergencies. Although we do hold a limited number of spare clothes on the premises in case of emergencies.

For children undergoing toilet training, more than one spare change of clothing would be helpful to bring in from home. As your child may have one or more accidents whilst adjusting to the changes from nappy to pants, particularly as young are often easily distracted when focused in play and have a tendency to 'forget' to go to the toilet.
